Friday, September 23

- Icebreaker at the Best Western Parkside Inn—North Room (exit 58 off of I-64 on U.S. 60) from 6 to 11 p.m. (see map on following page).

Saturday, September 24

- Field trip will meet at Doughdaddy's Doughnuts on U.S. 60 (Versailles/Lexington Rd.) at 8 a.m. (see map on following page).
The field trip will examine tectonic, stratigraphic, and sedimentologic aspects of the Lexington Limestone. We will be examining two different manifestations of the Lexington Limestone, one on the Bluegrass Parkway and the other at U.S. 127 North, to understand the origins of these differences.

- Lunch (from the White Light Diner) at Cove Spring Park.
- After lunch the field trip will reconvene at the limestone outcrop on the campus of Peaks Mill Elementary School, where interested teachers, students, and parents will join in on an "Earth Science Scavenger Hunt" to identify and discuss fossils and features in the rock that help geoscientists read and interpret the stories told by the rocks.

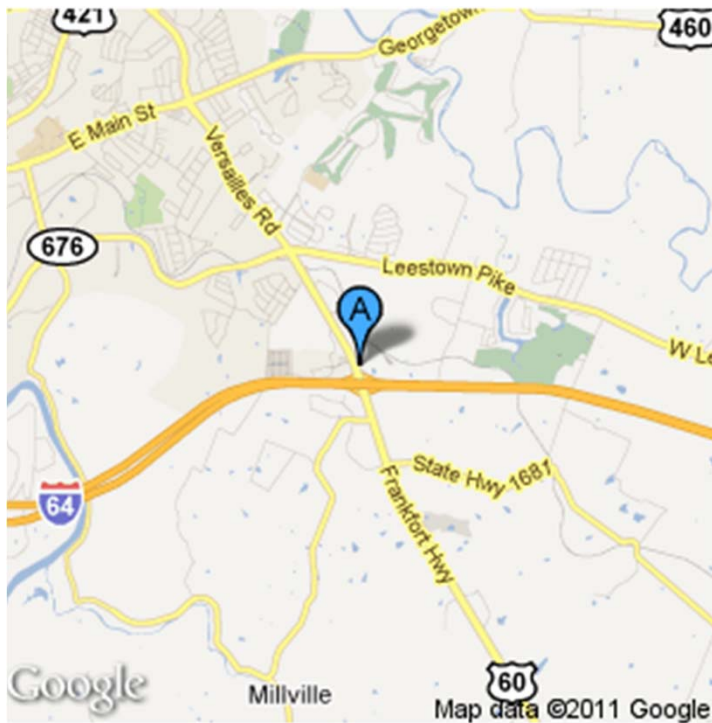

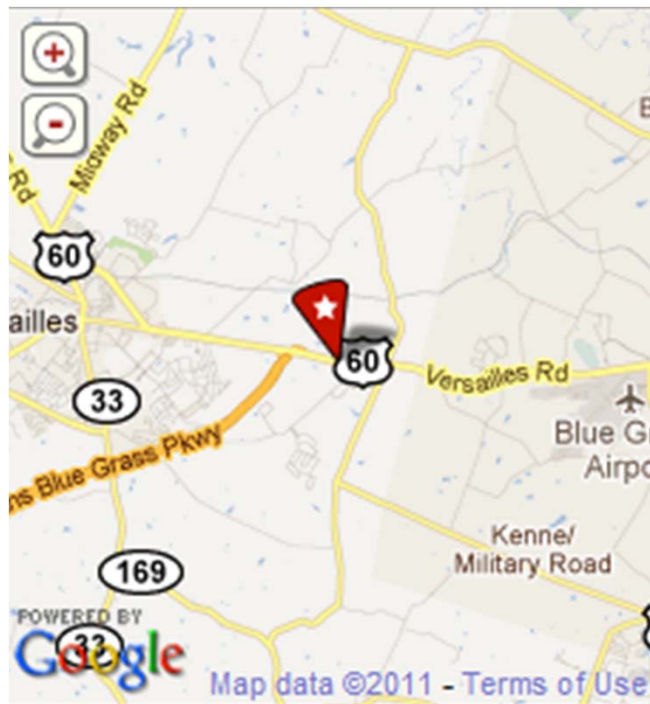

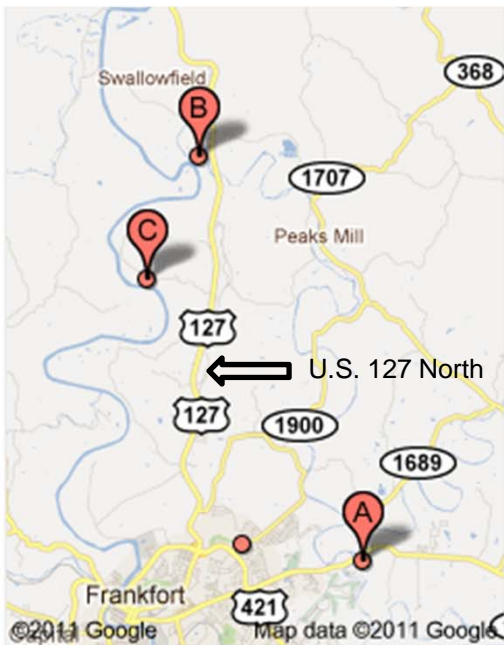
